**Annual General Meeting**

**November 2021**

The Sunrays have had an extremely successful 2020-2021 season even with extreme restrictions in place.

**Recreation:**

We had 7 athletes registered in this program. They were not able to attend a competition, due to restrictions but participated in an “in club” meet where they performed figures and routines in front of “judges” made up of coaches and athletes from the club.

**Provincial Stream:**

We had 2 athletes in this program last season. These ladies participated in 5 virtual competitions. Both Nevaeh and Hailey competed in the 13/15 Figure, 13/15 Solo and 13/15 Duet events.

**National Stream:**

We had 3 athletes in this program last season. These ladies participated in both provincial and national competitions virtually. Nadia competed in 13/15 figures, 13/15 Solo and Junior Free Duet events. Kate competed in both Junior Technical Duet and Junior Free Duet events and Keira competed in Junior Technical Solo and Junior Technical Duet events.

Regardless of Covid-19, the Sunrays have a lot to celebrate!

We have been successful with our gaming grant which we received \$15,500. The Legacy Sport Grant awarded us \$500.00 to upgrade equipment and Pacific Sports awarded us a coaching grant of \$5000.00. The BC Government also awarded us a \$7500.00 unrestricted sports development grant to help get us back in the water.
